

**Update: 5 March 2021**

Dear Colleagues,

As mentioned in our [email on 26 February](#), we intend to send out communications each week for the foreseeable future. We hope that this will provide further support to our delivering centres and detail any developments that may affect you and your learners.

**When will LIBF provide resources to support with the Teacher Assessed Grades (TAG) process?**

This week we have continued to work on the resource materials and guidance that we will be providing to centres to support and help with the TAG process. The use of our resource materials will not be compulsory but will be provided to help deliver the evidence that may be used in awarding TAGs. The materials will include questions and mark schemes designed to be more accessible to teachers. These may be used alongside other evidence for teachers to use when providing TAGs.

The Secretary of State has asked for support materials and resources to be available by the end of March; we are working very hard behind the scenes to meet this deadline.

**Should I be gathering any evidence now?**

At present we would advise that you continue to deliver and teach all LIBF qualifications in the normal manner. Students should still complete any questions / sample papers that you have set and marked as part of your normal taught lessons in any other year. We will provide much clearer guidance on the evidence required very soon; we hope to be able to confirm what all evidence will look like in our communication next week.

**Registrations of all learners**

Many LIBF qualifications require student registrations at the start of the course, however those studying LiFE, AiFE or CeFFCD (Wales only) can register throughout the year. If any of your students are expecting to receive a grade this summer, this could be via the TAGs process or via on-demand assessments where available (please refer to previous email), then please make sure that they are registered on the appropriate course. We will provide advance notice of when the final deadlines are as these may need to change due to the TAG process. It would be helpful if centres are putting together their final lists of registrations now and, where possible, submitting them via [MyLIBF](#) at their earliest opportunity.
