

**Update: 5 July 2021**

Due to Covid-19 the majority of examinations have been unable to take place in schools and colleges. As such, and in line with Ofqual's [Vocational and Technical qualifications contingency regulatory framework](#), our Financial Education qualifications will be assessed by Teacher Assessed Grades in 2021.

For our Financial Education qualifications made up of on demand assessments, in some cases centres have been permitted to continue taking the examinations where they were able to under public health guidance. However, where centres have not been able to complete the delivery as they would in a normal year these will also be assessed through Teacher Assessed Grades (TAGs).

Throughout this year we have provided centres with information on the process for supplying TAGs and how our internal quality assurance will work. **Level 3 (LIBF CeFS and DipFS) - 10th August 2021**

**Level 2 (CeFE/AiFE/CeFCCD/LiFE) - 12th August 2021**

The exams are available for CeFS Unit 2 and DipFS Unit 4, the dates of these assessments and other dates are on the key dates document. Students who wish to sit these exams will be expected to sit both parts A and B. The deadline for resit entry is Thursday 30 September. Students who wish to resit the CeFS Unit 1 and DipFS Unit 3 will be expected to sit both parts A and B in the January 2022 session
